As usual, we will split into two teams and play a 'Ryder Cup' style match.

Our package with the hotel is for three nights accommodation, so once again the cost this year also includes the additional extra night's bed and breakfast accommodation.

MONDAY 10TH JULY - ST ANNES OLD LINKS GOLF CLUB

- Breakfast at The Glendower Hotel
- 18 holes of foursomes matches (1st tee-time 9.45)
- Light lunch
- 18 holes of fourball-betterball matches (1st tee-time 2.15)
- Three course evening meal at The Glendower Hotel

TUESDAY 11TH JULY - FAIRHAVEN GOLF CLUB

- Breakfast at The Glendower Hotel
- 18 holes of singles matches (1st tee-time 9.32)
- Two course lunch followed by prize giving

Payment for this trip will be required FOUR WEEKS in advance.

There are only 18 single rooms available meaning there will almost certainly be more people wanting singles than those available. If you would be willing to share a twin room, please indicate this.

It is expected that all players are to play in all the matches. Anyone wanting to play only 18 holes per day should ideally find someone else who is also willing to do this before signing-up to this trip.

Please note that handicap certificates may be requested, so if you don't have a club handicap, you should try to get a certificate from another source if possible. The golf clubs are aware that not all of those attending have current handicaps but it would still be a good idea to have as many people as possible who are able to provide a certificate if these are asked for.

Most courses we play on tour do insist on handicap certificates, although we've never actually been asked to produce these. However, I'm giving you all warning just in case a club decides to be really strict.

Places will only be reserved when a £60 deposit has been received.

12 miles and approx 35 minutes from the hotel

Opened in 1932 and designed by James Steer, Fleetwood Golf Course is a typical links course playing the back 9 inside the front 9 and situated next to the sea.

The course is a definite must for keen golfers and for those willing to sample something other than an ordinary run-of-the-mill inland course. Fleetwood offers a challenge with prevailing winds being a major factor on how the course plays from day to day. It is a dry, long course with large greens and bunkers seemingly everywhere.

1 mile and approx 3 minutes from the hotel

A testament to its brilliance is its ability to hold its own in a region which boasts Open Championship venues including Royal Birkdale and Royal Lytham St. Annes. James Herd laid out the designs for it well over a century ago, a stunning, exceptionally challenging course, it really is an honour to be able to say you have played it.

FAIRHAVEN GOLF CLUB

Oakwood Avenue, Lytham St Annes FY8 4JU

3 miles and approx 10 minutes from the hotel

The course is an unusual blend of links and parkland which is relatively flat. This makes it not too strenuous to walk around and allows complete vision of each hole from tee to green. What you will see are fairways that are generously wide but with plenty of difficulty for wayward shots in the hills and hollows which border the fairways on most holes. Fairhaven is famous for its deep rivetted bunkers and there are plenty of them to give the golfer food for thought from both the tee and the fairway. This course, an Open Championship qualifier when the Open comes to nearby Royal Lytham & St Annes Golf Club, is situated in the heart of Lytham St. Annes. The golf course was partly laid down by the great James Braid, a former winner of the Claret Jug and respected golf course architect.
