#### **Friday 15th November 2019**

Arrive at Conwy Golf Club for full English breakfast  
18 hole fourball-betterball at Conwy Golf Club (1st tee-time 9.50)  
Evening meal and accommodation at The Dunoon Hotel

#### **Saturday 16th November 2019**

Breakfast at the hotel  
18 hole stableford at North Wales Golf Club (1st tee-time 10.08)  
Two course meal and prize giving at golf club

Situated on the North Wales coast, with spectacular views towards Conwy, Llandudno and across the sea to Anglesey, bordered by the Snowdonia hills, Conwy Golf Club boasts a superb championship links course. Conwy has hosted national and international championships since 1898 and is one of Wales' great links golf courses. Set among the sandhills, possessing true links greens and a profusion of gorse on the latter holes, the course provides the visitor with real golfing enjoyment against a background of stunning beauty.

North Wales Golf Club is one of the oldest on the Welsh coast and is a spectacular championship links course that held the Welsh Team Championship in 1995. The course offers an interesting variety of holes with small fast and tricky greens and fairways which run close to the seashore, overlooking Conwy bay with superb panoramic views of Anglesey and Snowdonia. The famous par 3 16th hole (named 'Oh Hell') is where, depending on the weather conditions, it is possible to utilise every club in the bag.

## CONWY GOLF CLUB

Approx 7 miles and 10-15 minutes from The Dunoon Hotel

Founded in 1890, Conwy has a distinguished history in championship golf and in July 2006 it became the first club in Wales to have the honour of being a local final qualifying venue for The Open Championship played at Royal Liverpool. The club also staged the 2007 Ryder Cup Wales Seniors Open. Situated between sea, mountains and a river, Conwy is a traditional links course that throws in deep bunkers, gorse and some very strong par 4's. Several of the holes of the front nine skirt the estuary itself giving views to enjoy over the bay to Llandudno, Anglesey and beyond. As the course turns to the back nine many of the holes are played beneath the splendid backdrop of the Conwy Mountains. When players reach the 15th tee the course enters into gorse country for what many have described as one of the most testing finishes in golf.

It is a natural links course in every aspect with the front nine like similar to Troon, in that it runs alongside a railway line with the homeward stretch along the coast.
